I can not find out because of said playback issue and it taking forever to make everything work. If someone could help me with the 2 questions I have It'd be much appreciated. Thank you.

I believe the whole discussion started because I proposed using MJPEG codec instead of other codecs in the command line I posted above to speed up your recordings with EyeFrame Converter.

Discussions about what is "the best intermediate codec" come up some times on this forum. You should treat them similarly to discussions about what is "the best car". Some believe that they've found the Egg of Columbus already, other doubt that there's an Egg of Columbus.

If you're satisfied with the results you get, continue going your own way. If you have additional questions come back and ask.
