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Welcome to the forum.

Since you're using phones, which uses a variable frame rate, rather than a constant one:

The V14.5 RC12 beta now supports variable frame rates (except AVI files), so it would be worth checking it out. It's very close to release, so is pretty stable; however, this is a new feature in this build being beta tested. It can be downloaded from the same page as V14.

If taking this route, ensure that "Apply VFR correction" is selected in the project menu (top left corner) under video, you can link to or transcode during import. If you have a lower powered computer using the Lightworks' internal proxy editing should reduce the load on your machine.. Details on P138 in the V14 User Guide found in downloads > documentation
