When you select YouTube for the export, don't tick the up load. Below you will find destination, select folder a menu will open giving you a choice of where you want to put your new video (you can create a new folder).

The fastest way to open the export panel for the current sequence is pressing F2-key. Alternatively, you'll find the menu entry 'Export' in several context menus (right-click on the object or the selection to export).
