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Hi

So I installed LWKS on my Fedora 30 dualboot system (runs file on win 10) with a Ryzen 2400G Vega 11 IGP. LWKS does not launch because of a missing Nvidia driver lib:

```
/usr/lib/lightworks/ntcardvt: error while loading shared libraries: libCg.so: cannot open shared object file: No such file or directory
```

Why does LWKS insist on this even on an AMD system just to startup run?

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I think that's because the list of dependencies within a .rpm package refers to all libs needed for an application to run, not specific to some hardware configuration.
