However, if I delete some portion of that same track, I do not get the out of sync indication. Why only when trimming and not when deleting? Either way, I am out of sync.

What you describe is unexpected behaviour.

With embedded audio, trimming to shorten or deleting the same portion of a segment of a single track should show the same segment sync loss and track sync loss.
