Right click on your timeline and select "Speed" from the drop down menu that appears. Select one of the speed presets, or type in your own. Done.

If you're using the flexible GUI you can also do it by switching your timeline to advanced mode and typing in the speed override directly.

To learn more about keyboard shortcuts, you can read the current V14.5 User Guide, starting on page 239, "Assigning a Keyboard Shortcut".

I mostly use a Contour Shuttle Pro V2, which works very well with Lightworks. There, the 'Play' commands from +/-10% up to +/-1,000% are assigned to steps (angles) on the shuttle wheel. For keyboard operations, I've assigned, 'Play backwards 1/2 speed' and 'Play 1/2 speed' to ALT+.
