Hello,

The video below shows, beside of many other valuable procedures, how to add a soundtrack to the timeline.

To remove, you can either use 'Sequence Commands.Tracks.Delete..' from the timeline menu or, mark and park the entire timeline, enable the tracks with the audio to be removed, disable all others, and use the symbol on the sequence viewer to remove (or Z-key). Also, with 'Auto track sync' disabled, you can drag and drop the audio to remove, one by one or applied to a marked section.

Hope that helps.
