Insert the clip into the timeline, switch to VFX mode and apply the 3D-DVE effect. To rotate use the parameter 'Rotation-Z', to scale 'Position-Z'.

Welcome to the forum.

If you're using a standard video camera. the standard aspect ratio is a landscape, it's not portrait. You're just adding problems in the land of video.

You can either use the 3D DVE or you can use the user custom effect format fixer.
