Check out the [CUSTOM AND USER EFFECTS](#) . In the designer transitions sections you'll find a wide range of transitions that can be used with titles.

When using them with titles, you should check out [USING DELTA TRANSITIONS](#) and [USING ALPHA TRANSITIONS](#) first. When adding our own transitions it's usually necessary to bypass Lightworks' own title blending. Those links will tell you how to do it.

If you want text to pop on a word at a time you will need to animate it on yourself. That can be as simple as masking it with a wipe, and keyframing the wipe position. If you don't understand what keyframing is you should check out the effects section of the Lightworks tutorials.
