Hello,

All settings of a single text effect apply to the whole effect, i.e. you have one font style per text effect. If you need more styles, you need more text effect, one per style. Depending on your design, instead of trying to synchronize multiple rolls, creating the credit roll with a text processor might be easier (and look better). Once finished with the design, save it as PNG, import it into Lightworks, and move it using the image effect with keyframes.

I'm not aware of any shortcut to insert the copyright symbol in the Lightworks text box. Create it in a text processor and copy and paste it to the text box .
