This is an occasional error that turns up. I would try uninstalling Lightworks, then downloading it again and reinstalling. Your project will be safe because it's stored in separate folders in the User directory, rather than the Program directory.

You can make a backup before doing this. It's the project menu in the top left corner of Lightworks under the details tab.

Lightworks 2020.1 automatically corrects the rotation angle. If you have done this manually with effects in a previous version, it is now rotated twice, which leads to an undesirable result.

You have two options:
