However his summary where he in essence said that it was unlikely to take off for cinema release I think is probably true.

However cinemas are not necessarily the future of the entertainment industry. High frame rates bring with them a whole slew of technical issues which can all be overcome if you throw enough money at them, but for a shrinking cinema market that probably isn't justified.
