

## [Solved] Mk1 Console - Windows 7 professional 64 bit drivers

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Hi, I trying to get a mark 1 console to work and am getting some success, but the console is not working. I have made up a cable with 12v and serial connection to a USB-serial adapter and I am using the RTCS console initialisation utility in demo mode. The utility reports that the c:windowsSystem32driverslwmoucon.ram file was missing.

I moved all of the files installed by the Editshare console setup installer (which where installed in c:windowsSysWOW64drivers) into c:windowsSystem32drivers and the RTCS utility reports that the EPROM is there and says init is done. But the red stop button does not light up and the console is not working in lightworks pro. Is there a specific console 64bit driver that I need to install

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I'm pretty sure the serial port settings are 9600 baud with 8-n-1. If you load up Teraterm or another serial terminal application you should be able to connect to the console and get it to display things. I have a list of known commands in another thread where I was trying to get mine to work. If you can't get the terminal to talk to the console, then the USB adapter is not capable of sustaining the signal voltages needed.

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I didn't install the FTDI drivers for the usb-serial device as mine is a prolific. see pics below for what my device maanger is showing, this may not help, this my not be the same for your usb-to-serial device. There is a pic that shows the uk ebay item for the usb-to-serial i a m using. This was the second usb-to-serial device I bought as the first device (not this model and make) didn't work, so just in case be aware that only some of the devices are windows7 64bit compatible. this one was very cheap, 5 pounds.
